
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Dear Families/Whanau

# <u>HOURS</u>

We have noticed a lot of out of hours drop offs and pick-ups creeping in 😕

School hour days are strictly 8:30-3:30pm - Please ensure that you stick to these times, not arriving in the centre before 8:30 and leaving at 3:30 (not arriving to collect at that time)

The Pukeko room have been trialling the children bringing in their own drink bottles from home each day so that they are better able to monitor the amount of water they are drinking throughout the day - this has worked so well that we are now making this an ongoing thing for the whole centre!
